Alice S. Anderson Bryant

(July 12, 1933 to February 10, 1985)

Alice S. Anderson Bryant was educated at Browns Wood Elementary School, Wiley H. Bates High School, University of Maryland and Cortez Peters Business School.

Alice Anderson was one of four girls and nine boys. She lived most of her life in Severna Park and the Annapolis area. Alice married and had three daughters and one son.

She was an active member of Asbury Broadneck United Methodist Church and an active member of the United Methodist Women. Alice was a devoted Christian, volunteer and served whenever asked. The Asbury Broadneck UMC was very important to Alice's life. At Asbury Broadneck UMC, Alice served as a Church School Teacher, Chairperson of Worship, Race & Religion, Finance, Evangelism, President of the United Methodist Women (UMW) 1976-1980 and a Lay Speaker. When it was time to build a new church, Alice, through faith and hard work, was instrumental in getting the present building erected.

Beyond her local church, Alice was involved as Vice Chairperson of Annapolis District Council on Ministry (ADCOM) in 1971 and afterward Chairperson for 7 years. She was involved with the Baltimore Conference Nomination Committee and the United Methodist Women for 6 years, School of Christian Mission Staff 1977-1981, Baltimore Conference UMW Membership Chairperson, Vice Chairperson & Membership person of Baltimore Black Methodist for Church Renewal (BMCR) and Conference Council on Ministry, Delegate Reserve for General and Jurisdictional Conference 1984, At Large Lay Member to Annual Conference and Board of Laity.

She was also a State of Maryland Chairperson for World Federation of Methodist Women. Other community involvement was Browns Wood Community Association, St. Margaret's Health Association, 5th District Precinct and the National Association for the Advancement of Colored People (NAACP).

Alice was both Chair and Vice Chair of the Annapolis District of Ministries and was a member of the Baltimore Conference UMW and served on the Board of Religion and Race.

Alice's most rewarding endeavor and life-long dream was her trip to Africa as a missionary in 1984. Alice was a pioneer and a significant force within the Annapolis District of the United Methodist Women. In 1986, following Alice's death, the Annapolis District UMW voted to establish a scholarship fund to honor Alice Anderson Bryant and provide financial assistance to those young people who are interested in following in her mission footsteps. In 1988, the Annapolis District Council of Ministries joined with the Annapolis District to establish this as the Annapolis District Scholarship Fund.

Alice Bryant Scholarship Application Procedure Information

Individual \$500 scholarships will be awarded annually

- Applicant must be an active member of an Annapolis District United Methodist Church
- Applicant must have a minimum GPA of 2.5. (**confirmed by most current transcript**)
- Applicant must be applying to be a full-time student at a community college or university carrying a minimum of 12 credit hours **OR** a part-time student carrying a minimum of 6 credit hours per semester/quarter.
- Applicant must explain scholarship needs (not more than 200 words) that would help the committee better understand your situation or any other circumstances that affect your situation that should be taken into consideration.
- Applicant must provide a letter of recommendation documenting active service to the ministry of mission in the church and the community from your pastor or his (her) designee.
- To renew a scholarship, a new application packet must be completed and submitted annually.
- All applicants will be expected to speak at one of the annual Annapolis District United Methodist events.

- The signature page requiring the applicant and pastor or designee signature must be completed and submitted with the application. **Incomplete applications will be rejected.**
- Scholarships will be awarded once applicant is accepted and enrolled in school and presented to each applicant by the Annapolis District United Methodist Women Alice Bryant Scholarship Committee at your home church.
